

JOB TITLE: Lineman First Class
DEPARTMENT/DIVISION: Maintenance Department
REPORTS TO: Public Works Supervisor

GENERAL JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Perform all assigned work on the Borough's electric system including all traffic signals, street lights and other related components and all electric utility service to consumers as directed by the Public Works Supervisor or assigned supervisor including any other duties as assigned.

SPECIFIC JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Perform all construction, scheduled and emergency maintenance, and repair on underground and overhead, primary and secondary electric transmission and distribution lines, substations, transformers, street lights, routine maintenance of traffic signals, electric meters, and electric utility wiring and components within the Borough owned electric system. Be able to troubleshoot and correct problems affecting all areas of the system without supervision.
2. Perform all work within established work and safety procedures and assist in training Second Class and Third Class Lineman in said procedures.
3. Possess the ability to effectively operate, manage, and properly control all assigned materials, tools, equipment and vehicles. Monitor project/activity progress insuring timely completion of work.
4. Possess the ability to design, layout, properly size, and position primary and secondary electrical system upgrade components and meter services.
5. Uses good discretion in speech and action.
6. Respond to emergency call outs after regular working hours when requested.
7. Implement and maintain records, reports, and standard procedures as required and/or as requested by the Public Works Supervisor including but not limited to routine meter readings, equipment maintenance reports, oil tests, etc.
8. Perform other work activities related to specific job responsibilities listed above and any other duties as assigned.
9. Ability to safely and effectively operate department equipment such as, but not limited to, the bucket truck, dump trucks, skid loader, and digger derrick.

REQUIRED CREDENTIALS

1. Hold valid PA Class B CDL Driver's License.
2. Minimum eight (8) years experience in primary electrical transmission and distribution systems including five (5) years electrical experience in the Borough's electric system. Must include direct responsibility for the tasks associated with design, layout, sizing, construction, operation, and maintenance of these systems.
3. Earned high school diploma or GED.
4. Lineman Training as required by Borough Management.
5. Proven skills in electric transmission and distribution construction, repair, and maintenance as a first class Lineman on either overhead and underground transmission and distribution systems or equivalent classification through an approved apprentice program.
6. Equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.

REQUIRED PHYSICAL AND MENTAL CAPABILITIES

1. Ability to perform hard manual labor.
2. Ability to lift 100 lbs.
3. Full use of all extremities.
4. Ability to read, write, and understand the English language.
5. Ability to work at heights up to 60 ft.
6. Ability to work in confined spaces.
7. Ability to accurately distinguish between colors.
8. Ability to walk, stand, bend, squat, and kneel for long periods of time.
9. Ability to work in cold, heat, and wet conditions for prolonged periods.
10. Ability to view operations and maintenance reports and documents.
11. Must work well with others.
12. Ability to work overtime hours as assigned by management.

13. Employee must be able to work in a bucket truck whose maximum weight limit is 350 pounds which includes employee's body weight as well as the 55 pound weight of the tools employee is required to use while working in the bucket truck.
