

JOB TITLE: Lineman Second Class
DEPARTMENT/DIVISION: Maintenance Department
REPORTS TO: Public Works Supervisor

GENERAL JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Perform all assigned work on Borough's electric system including all traffic signals, street lights and other related components and all electric utility service to consumers as directed by the Electric Foreman, Public Works Supervisor or assigned Supervisor, and any other duties as assigned.

SPECIFIC JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Assist in the performance of all construction, scheduled and emergency maintenance, and repair on underground and overhead primary electric transmission and distribution lines, substations, transformers, and other electric system components under direction of an Electric Foreman, First Class Lineman, Public Works Supervisor, or other assigned Supervisor.
2. Ability to perform all construction, scheduled and emergency maintenance, and repair on secondary electric distribution lines, street lights, traffic signals, electric meters, and secondary electric utility wiring from the primary electrical service transformer to all related underground and overhead distribution system components with minimal or no supervision.
3. Perform all work within established work and safety procedures and assist in training Third Class Lineman in said procedures.
4. Possess the ability to effectively operate, manage, and properly control all assigned materials, tools, equipment and vehicles. Monitors project/activity progress insuring timely completion of work.
5. Uses good discretion in speech and action.
6. Gather, document, and submit all forms and reports as required including but not limited to routine meter readings, equipment maintenance reports, oil tests, etc.
7. Respond to emergency call outs after regular working hours when requested and under guidelines of supervision as stated above.
8. Perform other work activities related to specific job responsibilities listed above and any other duties as assigned.
9. Ability to safely and effectively operate Borough equipment such as, but not limited to, the bucket truck and digger derrick.

REQUIRED CREDENTIALS

1. Proven skills in primary power line electric distribution work at a level described herein or equivalent proven qualifications through an approved apprenticeship program.
2. Hold valid PA Class B CDL Driver's License.
3. Minimum five (5) years work experience in the construction, repair, and maintenance of primary transmission power and electrical distribution system work including construction, maintenance, metering, and troubleshooting including three (3) years electrical experience in the Borough's electric system.
4. Earned high school diploma or GED.
5. Lineman Training as required by Borough Management.
6. Equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.

REQUIRED PHYSICAL AND MENTAL CAPABILITIES

1. Ability to perform hard manual labor.
2. Ability to lift 100 lbs.
3. Full use of all extremities.
4. Ability to understand, read, and write the English language.
5. Ability to work at heights up to 60 feet.
6. Ability to work in confined spaces.
7. Ability to accurately distinguish between colors.
8. Ability to walk, stand, bend, squat, and kneel for long periods of time.
9. Ability to work in cold, heat, and wet conditions for prolonged periods.
10. Ability to view operations and maintenance reports and documents.
11. Must work well with others.
12. Ability to work overtime hours as assigned by management.

13. Employee must be able to work in a bucket truck whose maximum weight limit is 350 pounds which includes employee's body weight as well as the 55 pound weight of the tools employee is required to use while working in the bucket truck.
