NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Borough Council of the Borough of Mifflinburg, County of Union, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the “Borough”), will, as part of its regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, October 19, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. at the Borough Office Building located at 120 N. Third Street, Mifflinburg, Pennsylvania, consider for enactment an ordinance establishing the procedures and requirements pertaining to the implementation of Act 50 of 2021, the caption and a summary of such proposed Ordinance being as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MIFFLINBURG, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT 50 OF 2021 AND REGULATING SMALL WIRELESS FACILITIES TO BE PLACED WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

The Ordinance establishes the procedures, requirements, and standards for deploying small cell infrastructure, also known as small wireless facilities, over public rights-of-way. Small wireless facilities are designed to add capacity in high-traffic areas where people use smartphones and other devices, such as dense urban areas and suburban communities.
